

Beading

Beading Feet are sold in sets of two, each having a different size of groove. Select the appropriate foot for the size of your beads.

Wide groove foot (L)...... For beads or pearls 2.5 - 4.0 mm in diameter Narrow groove foot (S)...... For beads or pearls up to 2 mm in diameter

Foot: Beading Foot (optional foot) Foot Pressure: 3.0 Stitch Width: 2.0 - 3.0 Stitch Length: 1.5 Thread Tension: 3.0 - 5.0 Needle Thread: Clear Monofilament Thread Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Tips:

- Choose beads that are strung on nylon thread. Those strung on cotton tend to break more easily.
- Beads strung on nylon thread tend to shift and form gaps during application. Affix tape to each end of the string before sewing to prevent the beads from shifting.
- 1. Draw an outline on the fabric where the string(s) of beads or pearls will be attached.
- 2. Place the fabric under the foot.
- 3. Arrange the string of beads or pearls on the fabric, and then lower the foot so that the beads fit in the groove on the bottom of the foot.
