Darning 1

The Memory Craft series automatically darns rips and holes.

The maximum darning area is 2 cm (3/4") long by 0.7 cm (1/4") wide.

Machine Settings:







Foot: Buttonhole Foot R

Foot Pressure: 3 Thread Tension: 4.2

Needle Thread: All-Purpose Thread Bobbin Thread: All-Purpose Thread

Tip:

- * For extra support, or to strengthen the darn, pin or baste a backing fabric to the wrong side of the fabric to be darned.
- 1. Attach buttonhole foot R, and fully extend the button holder.
- 2. Place a corner of the fabric under the foot. Press the Needle Up/ Down button twice. Draw the threads to the left side to ensure the threads are under the foot.
- 3. Place the fabric under the pressure foot. Lower the pressure foot and start sewing. The machine will sew 16 rows of darning stitches.
- 4. If the area to be darned is uneven, press the plus or minus key to adjust the length of the rows of stitches as necessary.
